A) Good afternoon! My name is Thomas Ernest Houdini and I am twelve years old. My mum's name is Ernesta Trista Houdini and she calls me Tom. She is a music teacher and can play the trumpet, flute, harmonica and trombone. My dad's name is Emanuel Theodor Houdini and he calls me Ernie. People call him His Majesty because he is the king of the Sahara Desert in Africa. We live in a magic royal palace far away from my grandparents, aunts, uncles and cousins. Our family is very big because my parents have many brothers and sisters. My mum's mum has five children and her name is Hui Ying, but her husband calls her Huhu. She comes from Beijing in China, but cannot speak their language. She can speak British English and Tamil. My grandma is very clever because only Indian people and people in Sri Lanka and Singapore can speak Tamil. My father's father has six sons and they have three sisters. His real name is Wilhelm August Emanuel Joel Houdini and he is 62 years old. He is the first king of the Sahara Desert, lives in Edinburgh in Scotland and likes travelling to other cities. His children live in Manchester, Prague, Budapest, Cambridge, Liverpool, Birmingham, Melbourne and Sydney.

B) I do not have any brothers or sisters, but I have one best friend. I call him Tommy and he is a friendly giant. He is five metres tall and quite fat. He has two blue eyes, a small nose between them and a mouth under the nose. His arms and legs are very long and his feet are big.
